

We meet on Thursday evenings at the Quarry Pool in Shrewsbury in the upstairs cafe area from 7.30pm. We have exclusive use of the pool from 8-9pm for dive training and practice or you can simply go for a swim. Members can bring family members along for swimming.

We have club compressor which members can use to fill diving cylinders. The compressor fills to 300 bar and fills with O2 clean air. The club also has a Haskell pump so members may blend Nitrox mixes (subject to qualification). Use of the compressor is included in the subscription.

We also own a RIB. From May-Sep there are usually monthly trips to the coast. Due to the weather, winter sea diving is less likely so then we tend to visit inland dive quarries instead. All diving members help to



organise dive days / weekends so that the responsibility doesn't fall on a few people. For diving trips the costs of running the trip (boat fuel, launch fees, accommodation, etc) are paid for by those going on the trip. All other RIB costs (servicing, registration, insurance, etc.) are covered by the club.

We run 2 dive courses each year for new divers and there are usually other courses running to allow existing divers to progress their skills if they wish to. Club members who have qualified as instructors give up their time to provide training. The club has nine sets of pool SCUBA equipment that Ocean & Discovery Diver students can use until they are qualified.

Qualified members need to supply their own kit, but we can often help you to build up your equipment and other members are sometimes happy to loan new members items until they manage to buy their own.

There is also a good social side to the club. We go to the Wild Pig pub on Thursday evenings after the pool session and there are regular meals out and a Christmas party.

Members joining the club as trainee Ocean Divers will be charged an annual fee at the time of joining. Upon their first anniversary, this can be changed to a monthly payment via BSAC direct debit.

The cost of undertaking the Ocean Diver course is £100. This includes all the instruction, use of SSAC pool equipment, course pack (provided by BSAC) and Nitrox tables. It does not include any entry charges or kit hire charges for your open water weekend.

At the committee's discretion, it may recommend to the membership that certain members have their subscription discounted or waived entirely in return for services provided to the club. Such matters must be voted for by the membership and must be reviewed annually.
